

A quick Look at Some Changes
for the 2018-2019 Year

The Consignment Center will **NOT** be accepting:

Books: both adult and children's, including cook books (Please donate them to the Hingham Public Library)

Men's Suits: we will still take clean, gently used sport jackets, blazers, and trousers

VCR tapes

Women's Polyester pants

Battery operated items without a working battery

Clothing items with logos of clubs, hotels, teams, etc

Infant or toddler equipment

Helmets

Junior clothing

Furniture

Hard wired electric fixtures

(and other miscellaneous items at our discretion)

Consigned items will be on sale at the regular price for 6 weeks. Consigners may retrieve their items at any time during the 6 weeks. At the end of 6 weeks, items become the property of the Consignment Center. Some will be given to charity, some sold for 1/2 price.

The Center's hours on Tuesdays will be 10 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (This is a change from the previous 8:00 p.m.)

Guidelines (revised in 2017)

1. Terms--60% to Consigner, 40% to Consignment Center

All items must be accompanied by a neatly and accurately completed consignment sheet (Blank copies available at the Center and on line.)

2. Clothing and cloth items must be clean and pressed, with no holes, pills, or stains. Clothing must be in season and in style. Kitchen and miscellaneous-items must be clean, with all necessary parts. Small appliances must be in working order. Battery-operated items must have working batteries. All items will be accepted at the discretion of the Consignment Center. Items found to be unacceptable will be give to charity.
3. Although all precautions are taken with consigned articles, rough handling and shoplifting occasionally occur. **We cannot be held responsible for damage or loss.**
4. The Consignment Center has the right to change the price of an item.
5. **The minimum price for each item is \$2.00.**
6. There is a limit of **TEN** items per customer per consigning day.
7. All sales are final, unless articles are taken on approval. The customer has one week to return an item taken on approval. If not returned, money being held is added to the sales of the day, and the sale becomes final.
8. Consigned items are on sale for **6 Weeks**. The consigner may remove the item at any time during that period. Items not sold or removed become the property of the Consignment Center and may be given to charity or sold for half price with any profit reverting to the center. (Note: there is no longer a 30% - off period)
9. Payout is available on or after the first Tuesday of each month for the previous month's sales. All money must be picked up. We do not mail money. Payout will be held for 4 months. All moneys must be picked up by that time.
10. Sales are held periodically. Clearance Sales are held at the end of each season. The dates of these Clearance Sales will be clearly posted. Consigners may remove their items prior to but not during the Clearance Sale. The Consigners will receive no compensation for items sold during a Clearance Sale. **Holiday items will be marked Half-Price after the holiday passes.**

The Consignment Center is operated as a nonprofit project by members of Hingham Congregational Church and is staffed by volunteers. All profits are used by the Center for various in-house and outreach projects. Inventory is reduced throughout the season and at closing time by donations to various local charities and nonprofit organizations.
